EU-CAYAS-NET is a project led by patient advocates under one of the flagship initiatives of Europe's Beating Cancer Plan to build a **European Network of Youth Cancer Survivors** and to create a knowledge centre and interactive platform for social networking.

Leading organisations from 18 countries active in the field will map resources for young cancer patients, survivors and their caregivers, create new European guidelines and empower cancer survivors to advocate for their rights and needs.

- **the quality of life of survivors** – including mental health, education & career support, follow-up care and transition from paediatric to adult health care,
