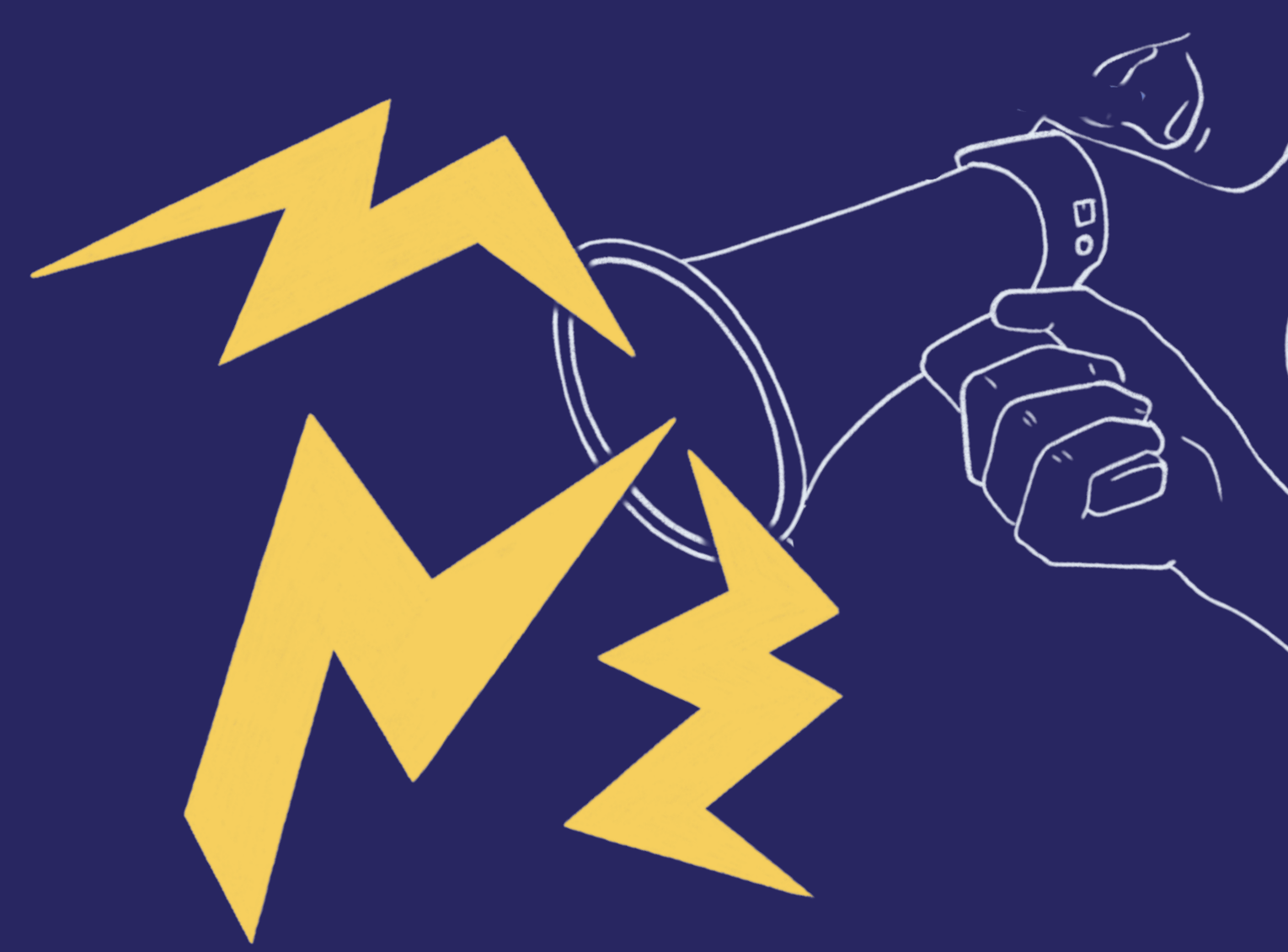




What is EU-CAYAS-NET?

EU-CAYAS-NET is a project **led by patient advocates** under one of the flagship initiatives of Europe's Beating Cancer Plan to build a **European Network of Youth Cancer Survivors** and to create a knowledge centre and interactive platform for social networking.

EU-CAYAS-NET fosters social networking, peer-support, knowledge-exchange, and will improve:

- the **quality of life of survivors** – including mental health, education & career support, follow-up care and transition from paediatric to adult health care
- the care for **adolescents and young adults (AYA)** with cancer, as well as
- **Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI)** along the whole treatment and survivorship trajectory.
